Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

To find out more or apply for this program, call Bill Scala at 369-4357 ext.227. If you are eligible the following documents will be needed:

- Picture Identification
- Proof of monthly income if you have any income at all
- Other resources: unemployment, SSI, SSD, VA, etc....
- Rental or mortgage documents in the applicants name (rent payment receipts are acceptable)
- Social Security numbers for all persons being included in the Food Stamp household (alien number for non-US citizens) also Birth Certificates for all children
- Latest bank statement if applicable
- Latest utility bills – electric, gas, water, etc.
- Child support payment documents (paying out or receiving) if applicable
- Vehicle Registration

This program could mean the difference between hunger and nutritional meals for you and/or your family. Don't let this opportunity go by.
